Dear Pat:

It has come to my attention that you plan to show portions of the videotape recordings (taken pursuant to the Order entered June 27, 2002, and which you introduced in the 2002 court proceedings in the form of a compact disc) at a seminar sponsored by Leadership Florida on Monday, August 30, 2004.

I also observed that portions of these same videotapes are contained for viewing by the public on the Terri Schindler-Schiavo Foundation website. As you know, your client is the president of the foundation and administers its website.

As you know, the aforementioned Order stating that the ward's estate owns the subject videotape, and that "neither counsel, the parties nor the selected physicians shall release, disseminate in any way or disclose said videotape of any portion thereof except in direct use in these proceedings or as otherwise ordered by the Court." Therefore, you and your clients may not release or disseminate the contents of those videotapes at the seminar or through the website, under penalties of contempt of court for violation of a court order.

Please do not show any portion of the above videotapes on Monday, and instruct your clients to remove the videotape portions from the website. Failure to comply with this request may subject you and your clients to contempt proceedings.

Thank you for your immediate compliance in this matter.
