ORDER


THIS CAUSE came on to be heard this day on September 3, 2004 upon Respondent Michael Schiavo's Motion for Protective Order, and the Court having reviewed the file, heard argument of counsel and being otherwise advised in the premises, it is hereby,

ORDERED AND AJDUGED, that the Motion is granted in part as follows:

1. The videotaped depositions of Michael Schiavo and Jodi Centonze may be taken.
2. Only parties and counsel of record as of July 20, 2004, may attend the depositions.
3. Each side is limited to the same number of lawyers in attendance at the depositions at any given time.

4. Neither the videotapes nor the transcripts of the depositions are to leave the possession of counsel of record in this case without prior Court approval.
5. Strangers to the litigation may view the videotapes and transcripts in the office of the respective counsels of record. However, no photographic images, copies, or reproductions of any kind, made by hand or by machine, of such videotapes or transcripts, in whole or in part, shall be made and distributed by or to anyone other than counsel of record as of July 20, 2004 without prior court approval.
